The University of New Mexico, International Mountain Medicine Center in collaboration with Mountain Guide Medical and the American Mountain Guides Association presents a Wilderness First Responder and Wilderness EMT recertification course specifically tailored to Mountain Guides.

Course Format:

8 Hours of self-paced online content begins October 1, 2017 followed by 16 hours of on-site practical work at the AMGA annual meeting on October 30 (8AM to 5PM) and October 31 (8AM to Noon)

Course Cost: \$240 per person

Participants must possess a current (unexpired) Wilderness First Responder card (inquire about grace period if needed). Upon completion of the course, participants will be issued a WFR certification card from UNM valid for 3 years.

Guides who hold a current EMT, AEMT, or Paramedic certificate may also re-certify the wilderness component to their WEMT with this course and receive EMS CE's.
